#### I. Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Programs

Symms National Recreational Trails Act (NRTA)	May 1	Pat Zatopa WDNR 715-365-8928	For acquisition, development, maintenance and rehabilitation of trails	Depends on availability of federal funds	50% match \$237,503/ yr statewide
Urban Green Space (UGS)	May 1	Pat Zatopa WDNR 715-365-8928	For acquisition of natural open space with scenic or ecological features	Urban focus	50% match \$750,000/ yr statewide
